



9. Sălașe

Sălașu de Sus – Paroș – Coroiеști – Râu Alb – Zăvoi – Sălașu de Jos – Sălașu de Sus



Approximate time: 2 hours

Distance: 16,7 km

Altitude difference: approx. 190 m

Surface: asphalt road, gravel road;

Difficulty level: easy;

Problems:

- The asphalt roads are narrow and sometimes the visibility is poor so pay attention to the traffic.

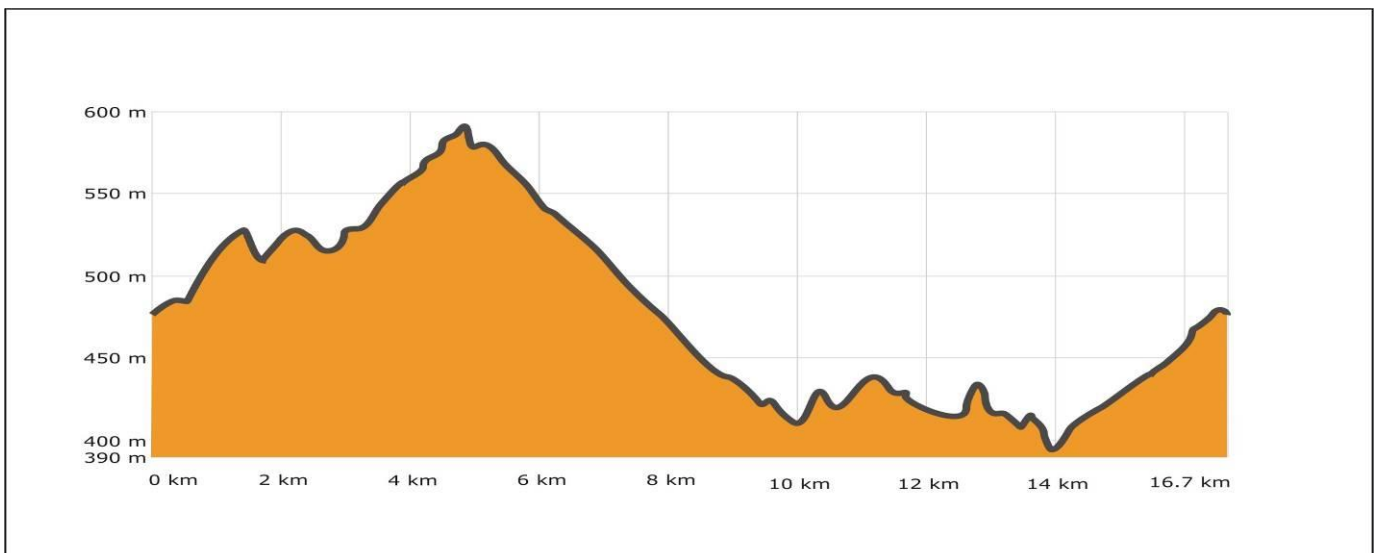
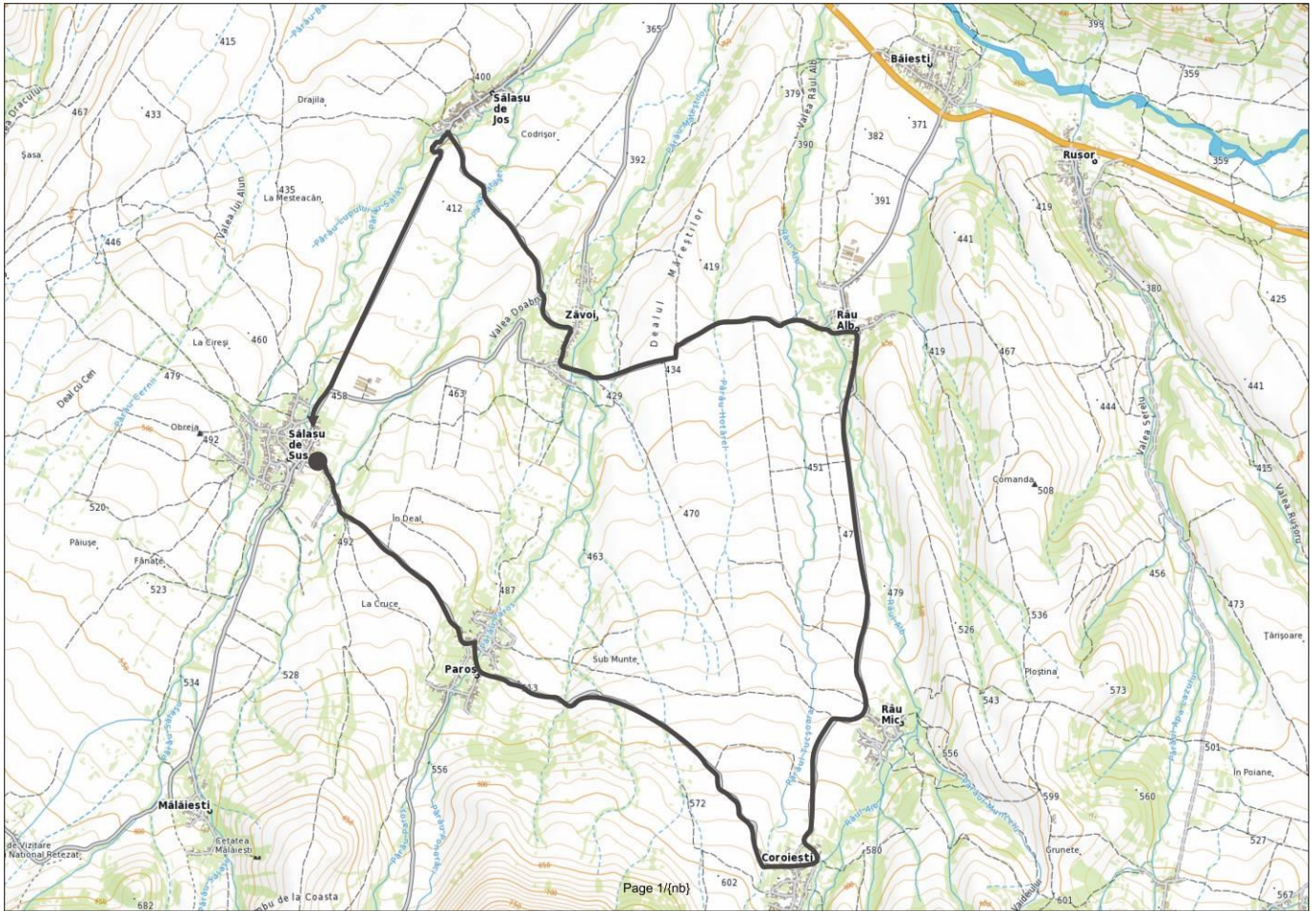
Unique features:

- The route passes through many villages that still preserve their traditional characteristics;
- In the church yard in Paroș you will find many stone crosses that are written in Old Romanian and even in transitional symbols from Cyrillic to Latin alphabet;
- Once you leave Sălașu de Sus, the area is less frequented by tourists in comparison to Sarmizegetusa, Mălăiești or Râu de Mori, so you will enjoy having an authentic experience.

From the centre of Sălașu de Sus village follow the road sign to Paroș village. Once you get to the village, in front of the school you have to follow the road to the right and then take on the first street to the left that leads to a narrow asphalted road to Coroiеști village crossing meadows and cultivated land.

Here the route turns left and descends to Râu Mic village that is located to the right of the main road. Right before Râu Mic village you will meet a road on the left that comes to Paroș. Keep right at this crossroads and then turn left at the next crossroads that leads to Râu Mic village and keep going until you reach Râu Alb.

At the first crossroads after you enter in the village turn left and at the next one go straight ahead on a narrow asphalt road that goes to Zăvoi village. Turn right on the first road and after 250 meters you enter on another narrow asphalted road that continues up to the edge of Sălașu de Sus village. Turn left on the first road that climbs more steeply, in serpentine and continue to Sălașu de Sus.
